



**CARE Nederland (The Hague) is currently looking for an:
Intern on Small Scale Renewable Energy and Resilience**

CARE Nederland (CNL) is part of CARE, an international organization that fights global poverty and provides life-saving assistance in emergencies. CARE Nederland hosts the CARE Climate Change and Resilience Platform (CCRP). This is a global platform across CARE International (CI) that unites CARE's work on climate change, and on increasing poor people's resilience to climate change, natural hazards, and environmental degradation – key priority areas in the CARE 2020 Program Strategy. The newly established CCRP has identified the need for an overview of CARE initiatives in the area of Small Scale Renewable Energy and Resilience. Various CARE country offices are engaged in this work and the CCRP would like to draw from their experience for learning purposes as well as to promote the scaling of successful initiatives. For the further development of this work, the CCRP is currently providing an internship opportunity.

The internship objectives:

The objective of the internship assignments is to support the CCRP in gaining an overview of CARE Small scale renewable energy initiatives. The task areas are:

1. Provide an overview of the various initiatives related to Small scale renewable energy in CARE Country Offices (including reach, impact and relation to increased resilience for the poorest and most vulnerable, with specific attention to women and girls).
2. Write a review on small scale renewable energy and its relation to increasing resilience of the poorest and most vulnerable, with specific attention to women and girls and key factors to success (through collecting and reviewing available literature and data, toolkits, examples, case studies and knowledge from within CARE).

The intern will work under the supervision of the CCRP Global Leader in the Netherlands, and will communicate and work with CARE country office staff where relevant.

We are looking for a:

- Master student who is looking for an internship (supervised by university)
- Independent and precise worker
- Fluent in English, and preferably proficient in French and/or Spanish
- Knowledge of small scale renewable energy and resilience
- Good communicator with good writing skills

Duration and location:

CNL prefers students who are available for 3 months for full time. But it's also possible to intern part time for 3-6 months. Payment will be 300 Euro gross a month for full-time. The internship will be based in the CARE NL office in The Hague. It's possible to work from home and to be in the office for one day a week (or to be decided otherwise).

Application requirements and deadline:

Please express your interest by email with your CV and letter (mentioning your internship requirements) to Inge Vianen before March 21, 2018. Interviews will be held on 27 March 2018. The selected candidate will engage in a contract with CARE Nederland in which the supervision by both CARE as well as the University will be detailed. If the selected candidate is not enrolled in a Dutch University, a contract will be issued with the University that the student is enrolled at.
